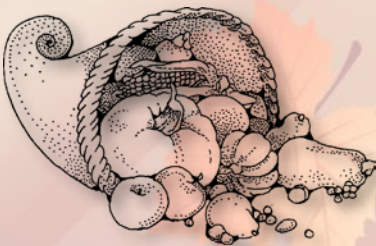

Sanctuary Worship Guidelines

- ❖ If you or someone in your family is sick, please stay home.
